Travel Information

Travelling by Air:

Stansted is the closest airport to Ufford Park and is 1 hr 30 minutes away. It is a large airport with flights going everyday to and from Europe. A bus service takes you from Stansted to Ipswich, the closest mainline train station.

Travelling by Sea

Harwich is the closest port to Ufford Park which is 55 minutes away. It has regular Ferries to and from Esbjerg Denmark through DFDS, Europort Rotterdam through Stena BV and Hoek Van Holland also through Stena BV. Regular direct trains run from Harwich to Ipswich.

Travelling by Train:

The closest mainline train station to Ufford Park is Ipswich which is 25 minutes away with regular trains to and from London and easy connections to Kings Cross St Pancras for the Eurostar.

Accessibility

The only way to access Orford Ness is to travel by National Trust Ferry, which will be arranged prior to your visit.

There is designated disabled parking, disabled toilets, induction loop and seating available.

The buildings and the ground itself may have steps or uneven terrain.

Ufford Park
